

CRRC Omnibus Survey, Wave 20

Fact sheet

Population: The adult population of Georgia living in Tbilisi-administered territories, except in areas of Abkhazia and South Ossetia.

Sample size: 1,307 completed interviews according to AAPOR standard definitions (50% of eligible variables are answered by the respondent)

Fieldwork dates: April 29 - May 8, 2024

Minimum response rate (AAPOR RR1): 17%

Interview mode: Interviewer-administered telephone phone survey

Interview languages: Georgian, Armenian, Azerbaijani, Russian

Survey design: Random sample from the list of the available phone resource.¹ Each phone number is treated as a personal-use device.

Primary sampling units: individuals.

Strata: Capital (Tbilisi), urban, rural settlements

Weights: Results are weighted. Base weights are adjusted using the 2014 National Census data for controlling respondents' gender, age, ethnic identity, education, and residence. Population counts by groups (settlement type, gender, age, education, ethnic identity) are calibrated using the iterative proportional fitting (raking) algorithm.

Average theoretical margin of error does not exceed 3%

Back checks: Ten percent of all interviews were checked via call-backs.

¹ Available phone resource is the potential list of indexes and phone numbers that are assigned to cell phone operators by Georgia's National Communications Commission (ComCom). Overall, there are 8,410,397 potential phone numbers available in the phone resource list.
